TRANSPORTATION

Check out the T-Casual card in the transport stations.

You can use it on buses, trams, and the metro across different zones, giving you flexibility for your daily travels. With 10 trips to use, this card is super handy, especially if you live in the city center.

1. El Xampanyet \$

C/ DE MONTCADA, 22, CIUTAT VELLA, 08003 BARCELONA

El Xampanyet is a tapas bar in the El Born district named after the homemade sparkling wine that it serves. Great tapas, both funky and traditional vibes. Great mix of locals and tourist all day long. No reservations. (Keep in mind, tapas are finger foods!)

FCB museum
